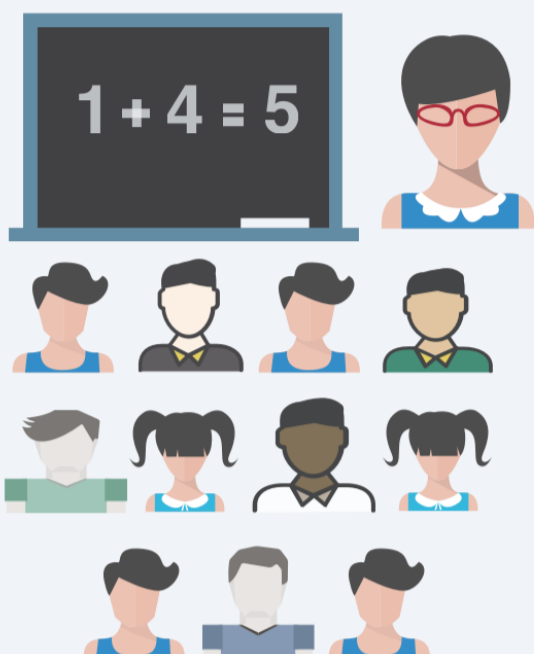
Step 1:

- ES Recommendation

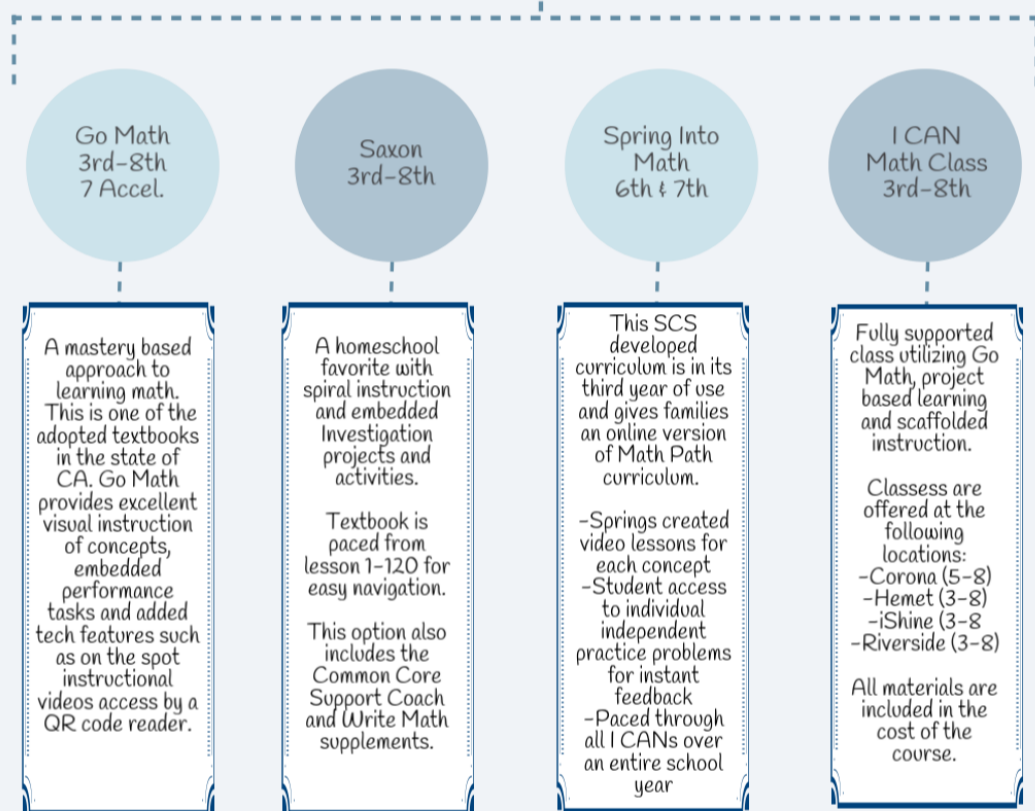
Once students have been identified for Math Path, the personalized program takes shape to help each student reach math proficiency.

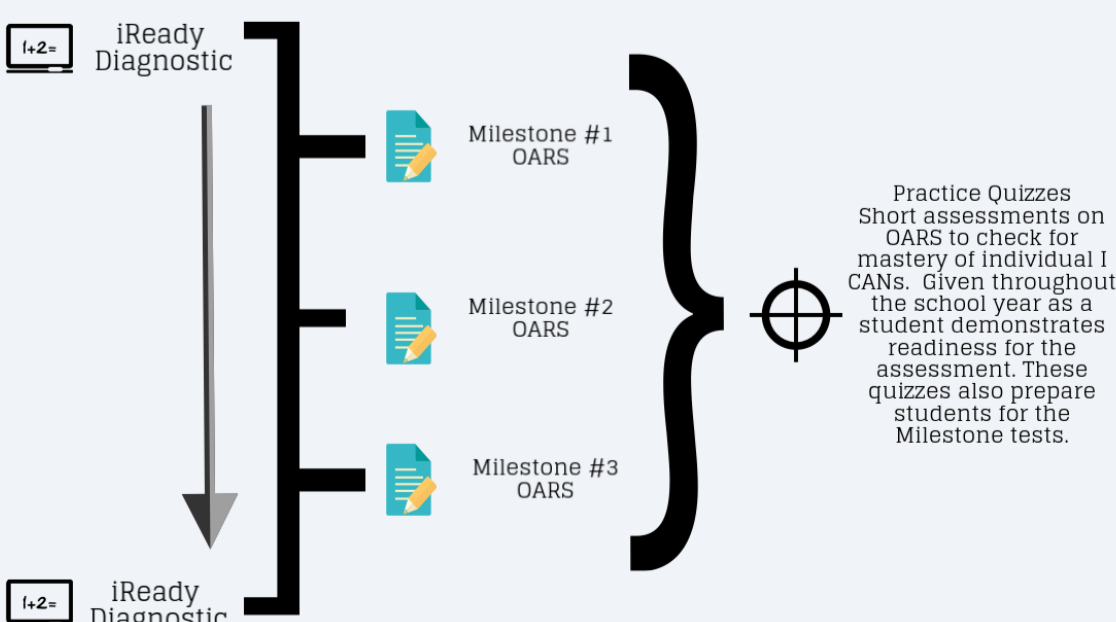

Math Path Annual Assessment Plan
