



**Special Notice: W. Grand Boulevard at the 91 Closed Nightly
8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
February 9 to 13, 2015
Tree Removal Activities throughout February 2015**

As part of the Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project, the W. Grand Boulevard undercrossing at the 91 will be closed nightly February 9 to 13, 2015, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. for the removal of a portion of the bridge. Please use Main Street or Lincoln Avenue as alternate routes.

On or around February 16, 2015, W. Grand Boulevard, between N. Sheridan Street and Third Street, will be reduced to one lane in each direction and traffic will shift to the middle of the roadway. The lane reductions will allow crews to work on widening the bridge safely behind k-rail.

Once work is complete on the outside portion of the road, traffic will shift back to the outside lanes and work will move to the middle portion. These travel conditions are expected to continue into 2016.

Additionally, tree removal activities will take place throughout February 2015 in areas that include, but are not limited to Wardlow Road, Pomona Road, Serfas Club Drive, Northmoor Drive, Bollero Place, Isabella Way and Buena Vista Avenue. Tree removal is necessary to clear working spaces in various areas of the project limits so that improvements can be made.
