

River Springs dress code

Hemet River Springs Student Center students all must wear uniforms throughout the school year. Polo shirts and uniform bottoms must be worn daily. Tk-2nd grade students are required to wear a royal blue polo shirt while 3rd-5th grade students are required to wear a red polo shirt. Polo shirts with the River Springs Crest are available for purchase at the online Springs Spirit Store and on campus while supplies last, however students are not required to wear a shirt with the River Springs crest. Bottoms include pants, skirts, shorts, and jumpers; all which may not be more than 2 inches above the knee. Bottoms must be made of cotton twill (Dickies fabric) in uniform style in either Navy blue, black or Khaki color. Tights/leggings may be worn *only* if underneath shorts, skirts or jumpers. All clothing is to fit appropriately without excessive sagging or tightness. RSCS sweatshirts and hoodies are available for purchase on campus but if you prefer to purchase your own elsewhere, Tk-2nd grade students may wear a *plain* royal blue hoodie or zip-up sweatshirt free of any logos/pictures, while 3rd - 5th grade students can wear a *plain* red colored hoodie or zip-up sweatshirt free for any logos/pictures. There are even more options available on the online Springs Spirit StoreCRSCS spirit shirts are for sale at the site while supplies last and may be worn instead of the polo with the approved bottoms on **Fridays only**. You may purchase your students uniform from wherever you prefer, as long as they meet all requirements. If students arrive at school out of uniform or wearing inappropriate clothing they must call home for the correct clothes to be brought to them.

Occasionally, students are given the opportunity to wear clothing of their choice for spirit days, picture days, etc. Please note the standards for dress must remain appropriate and modest.

- Clothing that exposes undergarments (sagging or low cut pants, low-cut tops and tops that expose bra straps)
- Garments that, when standing, sitting or walking, show stomach, shoulders or back (whole or partially)
- Hats are not to be worn any time in the building
- Shoes that are not closed toed (grades K-5)
- See-through garments
- Pajamas or slippers (except during Spirit Week)
- Garments with pictures, wording and/or symbols depicting the following:
 - Sexually explicit content or numbers
 - Tobacco, Alcohol, Drugs or associated paraphernalia
 - Lewdness or Obscenity (including nudity or nude silhouettes)
 - Offensive Content (including foul language)
 - Hate or defiance
 - Violence or Weapons (brass knuckles, grenades, guns/knives
 - Gang affiliation
 - Belt buckles with inappropriate symbols or initials
 - Chains or spiked apparel or accessories. Including safety pins as jewelry or accessories.

Female specific items not allowed

- Tube tops
- Any top exposing any part of bra (including straps)
- Low cut tops that expose cleavage
- Bandanas worn or exposed to depict gang affiliation (at administration's discretion)
- Tight Pants

Male specific items not allowed

- Bandanas worn or exposed to depict gang affiliation (at administration's discretion)
- Sagging/Tight pants
