Classical Literature & Writing Club	Introduce your child to the power of experiential learning and create memories that will last a lifetime by interacting with history through literature and writing. In this Classically-themed ELA class, students will engage in reading novels such as <i>Who Was King Tut</i> and <i>The Egypt Game</i> as well as follow the IEW History-based writing lessons and learn to write with structure and style. This class will follow the current classical cycle and explore Ancient History. By reading and discussing novels about events of the past, students will have a better understanding of how this particular period of history influenced life today. While students travel back in time, they will learn to take notes, retell narrative stories, summarize references, write from pictures, compose essays, and more. *Students taking this class will be required to bring his or her school-issued Chromebook to class every week.
Countries & Cultures	Countries & Cultures will take a deep dive into some of the countries found on all seven continents! We will begin with learning geography and then explore different cultures through art, food, celebrated holidays, and day-to-day activities. This hands-on class will include learning cartography, geographical terms, and cultural appreciation through experiences and projects. Students will learn about each country's history, government, and socio-economic status. In learning about the different cultures around the world, students will better understand the world around them and become more accepting of others. "A nation's culture resides in the hearts and in the soul of its people" Mahatma Gandhi.
Crowning Moments with Performing Arts	This class introduces students to the art of performing, to develop an appreciation of the art, and understand how various acting techniques may be used to heighten one's awareness and as a tool for self-realization. They will also get to try their hand at creative communication through cursive and calligraphy. Cursive is an essential tool for cognitive development, and calligraphy is an art form. Key into this class for aspiring scribes. *Students in grades 3-8 taking this class will be required to bring his or her school-issued Chromebook to class every week.
Digital Dignitaries	Come improve your digital skills and explore the world of computer science with coding! Have you ever wanted to learn more about the world of computers? Have you ever wondered if your child can learn computer programming? The answer is YES! In this class, students will have the opportunity to explore what it means to be a computer scientist! They will learn what computer science is, dive into the fun applications of this fascinating world, and understand how to be a part of computational thinking while learning new problem-solving skills and more. Students will create and program interactive games, art, and activities with block-based coding in Code.org and Scratch. This course will also include working with Google Apps like Docs and Slides, as well as typing practice, so students will also feel confident using these tools in any of their classes. These concepts will improve their testing, and allow their creativity and productivity to be unleashed! *Students in grades 3-8 taking this class will be required to bring his or her school-issued Chromebook to class every week.
EmpowerU: Health, Wellness & Life Skills	Springs cares about the whole child! Utilizing the new and exciting Studies Weekly Health and Wellness curriculum as a starting point, students will develop physical, mental, social, academic, and emotional health and wellness skills and dispositions. From the Great Depression and Dust Bowl era explored in <i>Esperanza Rising</i> to the history of music explored in <i>Trombone Shorty</i> , students will not only uncover the gripping narratives of these novels but also explore the cultural and social landscapes of the time. Through thought-provoking discussions, engaging activities, and interactive learning experiences, students will develop a deeper appreciation for history and literature, making connections that bring the past to life in vibrant detail. Join us in the <i>Historical Fiction Book Club</i> where the pages of history come alive through the power of storytelling!
	Master the I CAN!s in a fun group setting!
*I CAN! Math	The program's structure and requirements are in place to help each student succeed! A highly qualified, credentialed teacher will plan lessons and teach this course using various strategies personalized for every learner. In addition, there will be several components to the class, including textbook lessons, interactive small group instruction, supported independent practice, hands-on centers, and an online math component called iReady. Students must complete 90 minutes of structured math assignments on the additional three home days each week guided by parents, including personalized practice with iReady. Students are expected to attend class two days per week regularly. The teacher, TOR, parent, and the student will be required to sign the I CAN! Math Roles & Responsibilities form. The I CAN! Math teacher will give all assignments and assessments instead of the TOR. Parents are expected to be facilitating the lessons on home study days, making sure students complete their assignments and understand the concepts. The I CAN! Math teacher is available by phone or email to help support both the parent and student at home. It's a beautiful partnership! *Students taking this class will purchase the books through Bookmart and are required to bring their school-issued Chromebook and Math textbook to class each day they attend. Students must take their math assessments and iReady diagnostics onsite. **Students MUST enroll in Part 1 AND Part 2 and attend regularly to continue enrollment in this class.
Imagineering ~ Discovering Disney	Explore the creative, musical, and scientific side of Disney Magic! In this class, Disney's Imagineers from around the world will share how they use a wide range of skills – from story development and conceptual design to math, physics, and engineering – that all come together with art and music to create immersive experiences. This class will also include the Imagineering in a Box curriculum designed by Pixar. This program allows students to explore different aspects of theme park design, from characters to ride development, as they create a theme park of their very own.
