PROGRAM INFORMATION

Get an inside look at how Disney animators create full-length animated features. Learn the history of the artform, develop storytelling skills and practice techniques used to bring some of the most beloved characters of all time to life.

Learn about the complex components that work together to bring favorite Disney characters and stories to the big screen. In this 3-hour program, students will study Disney's role in the history and processes used to create early animated features, as well as the innovative animation techniques used to bring the visions of modern storytellers to life. Students will explore their own storytelling skills by designing a storyboard and creating a kineograph.

STUDENT WILL LEARN

During this interactive field study, students will:

- Articulate various elements of Walt Disney's animation pipeline
- Describe Walt Disney's contributions to the field of animation
- Understand the history and progression of animation from handdrawn to computer
- Draw a Disney character using simple geometric shapes
- Demonstrate storyboarding
- Create a kineograph
- Create a thaumatrope
- Articulate the physical process of the theory of persistence of vision
- Calculate the number of frames needed in a 60-minute animated film
