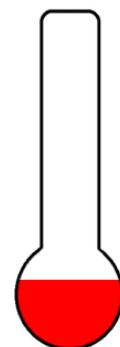

Uniform Policy Reminders

P.E.

Remember that Tuesday's and Thursday's the students have PE and should be dressed and prepared.

Please make sure they are wearing the right clothing and comfortable shoes that they can run and play in. This is important for their safety and their ability to participate with their class.

For PE days, students may wear a plain Royal Blue shirt or Bear River Spirit Shirt with black athletic bottoms.

They should have a refillable water bottle, too. It's been very hot and we want to make sure they stay hydrated.

Drop Off/ Late Check -In/Early Checkout

There is no supervision before 8:00 am.

Please do not drop your students off before then. Students who arrive after 9am or are picked up before the end of the day at 3pm, must have a parent come to the front office to check them in or check them out early.

When picking up your student early, please be prepared to show your ID. Thank you for your help!!

If you are picking up your child early please do so before 2:00 pm. After this time the kids and staff will be preparing to leave for the day.

Cell Phone Policy

Students should not have their cellphones on them. They are to remain off and in their backpack during school hours.

If there is an emergency and you need to be able to contact them, please notify the front office in writing.

Students receiving texts and calls during school are being distracted and distracting others doing work.

Your child should come to the front office if they need to make a call.

If their cellphone is taken away, a parent will need to come to the front office to retrieve it.
