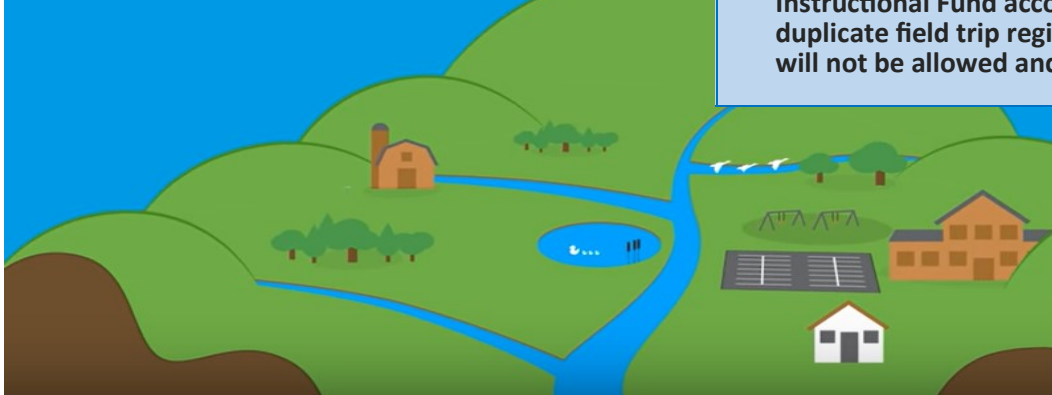


SPECIAL GUIDELINES:
