Springs Launches Free Public Open Classroom Online During Pandemic for Grades K-12, Open to All Students

TEMECULA, CA, March 26, 2020 – Springs Charter Schools has launched a free public open classroom for students in grades K-12. Participation allows children to continue their education at home with daily lessons during this time when on-site classroom education has been suspended due to the COVID-19 pandemic at least through April 30. **Lessons are free and may be accessed by all families, whether they are enrolled at Springs or not.** To access the curriculum, visit www.SpringsCS.org/OPEN-Classroom.

No enrollment is necessary; content is aligned with California state standards. Material has been created and is supported by credentialed teachers, with live classes taught by credentialed teachers four days per week. Weekly lesson plans with materials provided, including parent answer keys and resources. Subjects covered include math, science, language arts and reading. Teachers also may access material for their students.

Springs Charter Schools are tuition-free, public schools of choice serving more than 9,500 California school children and their parents. Many Springs parents choose to homeschool full-time, while others choose two to five days per week of a blended model that includes classroom instruction with home study. Springs serves students in student centers in the Counties of Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego, Orange and Los Angeles.
