The Board of Directors views school accountability report cards (SARC) as excellent ways to inform the community about conditions, needs, and progress at the school and to help provide data by which parents/guardians can make meaningful comparisons between schools. In addition, the process of developing the school accountability report cards provides the school staff opportunities to review achievements, identify areas for improvement, enlist local support, and establish a vision for the future.

The Superintendent shall maintain a process for developing the annual SARC with input from segments of the school community. After the SARC is issued, the Superintendent shall provide opportunities for staff and the community to discuss their content and strategies for communicating the information contained in the SARC to all stakeholders.
