

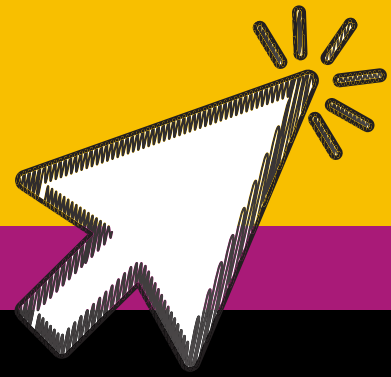

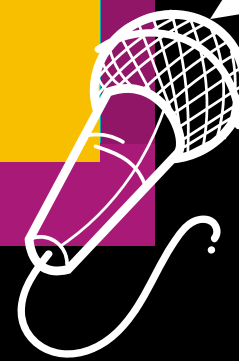


ALL SPRINGS STUDENTS Academies & ILP (4th-12th)
