



**Subject:** Immigrant Students and Families

**Policy:** 5030.1

Assembly Bill (AB) 699 requires all California public schools to provide protections for all California resident students, regardless of immigration status, and extend specific support to immigrant students and their families. The Bill requires that schools adopt supportive practices in response to heightened immigration enforcement, including:

- Updated staff training
- Curriculum development
- Implement measures to prevent students from being discriminated against or bullied based on their immigration status.
- Ensure schools are teaching students about the harm of bullying students based on immigration status.
- Report police enforcement of immigration laws to school boards.

Inform parents about their children's right to free public education and about policies to resist assistance with immigration enforcement at school, including the collection of immigration status or documentation of citizenship of pupils or their family members.
