#### Graduation Registration Opens February 1, 2023

**An online [Graduation Registration Form](#) must be completed for all seniors, regardless of whether the student plans to attend the graduation ceremony. The deadline to complete the Graduation Registration Form is March 15, 2023.**

Graduating seniors may participate in the graduation ceremony if:

- The student has completed the graduation requirements (or is within 5-10 units of completing graduation course work AND is enrolled in summer school). ***If you anticipate that your student may not meet the graduation unit requirement we encourage you to be in touch early and often with your school counselor to discuss options and opportunities.***
- The student is in "good standing" in regard to citizenship and behavior. Participation in Springs' graduation ceremony is a privilege. Students will be notified in writing if the privilege to participate has been withdrawn based on non-academic issues.

It is a very special time for parents, relatives, friends, teachers, and school staff who have given their support and share in the graduate's excitement. 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### **Parking:**

Self-Parking is available in the East Parking Structure located at 45410 Pechanga Pkwy, Temecula, CA 92592. Heading South on Pechanga Parkway, turn RIGHT on Pechanga Resort Drive. The entrance to the structure is immediately to the RIGHT. Valet parking is also expected to be available. The cost will be \$10 per vehicle.

## Cap and Gown Information

Students are expected to wear a solid black cap and gown (matte finish is preferred) in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. A tassel matching the color of your sash with a "2023" charm will be provided. Students can purchase a gown or borrow one from a sibling/friend.

There are many economical choices available to purchase caps and gowns online. This is an example of a cap and gown you can purchase on [Amazon](#) for approximately \$30.

Students may decorate the top of their cap only and it must be done tastefully. ALL decorations MUST lay FLAT on the cap. Nothing can lay perpendicular thus allowing us to see the decoration beyond eye level. Nothing can hang from any side of the cap. Your cap cannot make noise such as bells or horns. Cap designs must be school appropriate and cannot include offensive language, flags, or derogatory names/statements.

*If purchasing a cap and gown presents a financial hardship, you can borrow a cap and gown on the day of the ceremony. Quantity is limited. Please email [events@springscs.org](mailto:events@springscs.org).*

## Graduation Regalia (Tassel, Sash, and Medallion)

All students participating in the graduation ceremony must wear a black cap and gown (purchased independently) with a coordinating tassel and sash. The 2023 Graduation Regalia package can be purchased for \$20. The package includes a coordinating tassel and sash specific to the graduate's program as well as a commemorative medallion.
